ORDINANCE NO. 2008.44

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE AND ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF AN EXISTING ALLEY LOCATED AT 1000 EAST APACHE BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the City of Tempe owns the portion of the alley described herein and shown on Exhibit "A" hereto and legally described on Exhibit "B" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it would appear to be in the best interest of the City of Tempe to abandon a portion of said alley, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That subject to compliance with the conditions stated below, the City of Tempe does hereby abandon, relinquish and vacate that portion of the existing alley shown on Exhibit "A" hereto, and legally described on Exhibit "B" hereto, conditioned on payment of the consideration referenced below.

Section 2. That all rights of the City in the portion of the alley abandoned shall be conveyed by quit-claim deed to the record owner(s) of the adjacent property subject to the same encumbrances, liens, limitations, restrictions, and estates as exist on the land of which the abandoned alley is a part.

Section 3. That in consideration the abandonment and conveyance of the alley, the applicant shall pay to the City an amount equal to the fair market value of the abandoned alley, such value to be determined by the Public Works Manager or his designee.

Section 4. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any documents that may be necessary to implement this Ordinance. Pursuant to City Charter, Section 2.12,

ordinances are effective thirty (30) days after adoption.


