

Enameling Supplies

The instructor will review the supply list with students during the first week. Only items marked “Required items for first class” must be brought to the first class.

Required items for first class:

Safety glasses—should be comfortable and completely cover your eyes

Closed-toe shoes (no sandals or open-toed shoes)

Dust Mask or Respirator

Emery paper - Wet/Dry (180, 220, 320, 400, and 600 grit, at least one sheet each)

Copper and Fine Silver Sheet 18 or 20 gauge = 2 - 1”x3” Pieces of Copper, 1 - 1”x3” Fine Silver

(will need more for the rest of class, only sold in 6”x6”Copper and 1”x6”Silver increments, any extra may be used later)

Apron or Old Clothes

Ruler

Inlay Tools or Clean Wax -Working Tools (Dental tools work well)
