

## Supply List Mixed Media Class

Welcome to the Mixed Media Class

We will be working with papers, paints, tile, and collage type materials. There are magazines, art books, papers, paints and paintbrushes in the classroom for you to use. You are welcome to bring your own paint brushes, paints and other supplies you may have.

**You will not need to have all the supplies at the first class.** We will work on a paper project and I'll go over the list at that time.

### Supply list

- **Assorted papers** – these can be (but not limited to) scrapbooking papers, card stock, music sheets, maps, clip art books, copies of photos, magazine pictures, postcards, postage stamps, antique book pages, sewing patterns, shipping tags, internet pictures, paint chip samples and whatever else can be adhered to a piece of work. *JoAnn's, Michaels, thrift stores, antique stores and Bookman's are great places to look.*
- **Embellishments** – these can be from home or store bought trinkets such as stencils, ribbons, chip-board letters, buttons, brads, stamps and jewelry charms. Also “found items” such as memorabilia, keys, coins, playing cards, leaves, feathers, shells, pressed flowers, fabric and game cards or pieces. *Thrift and antique store are great places to look, as is JoAnn's or Michaels.*
- **Matte medium** or Ultra Matte Medium (made by Liquitex) or **Mod Podge** (matte finish). Matte Medium is in the fine art section at Jerry's Artarama, Michaels or Joann's where the artist's paints are. This is a multi use medium that is used as a glue, sealant, and for finishing paper and anything else you would like to cover.
- **Mounted canvas**, square or rectangle, thick or thin. May want to purchase several. Jerry's Artarama, Michaels or Joann's has canvas.
- **Watercolor paper**. Try finding a small pad (5.5" x 8.5"). We will use this size for a book. Fry's Marketplace carries this size in the craft section as does Jerry's Artarama.
- **Tiles for Mosaic project** – this can be tiles, marbles, glass tiles, beads, dishes or any object that can be adhered to a project.
