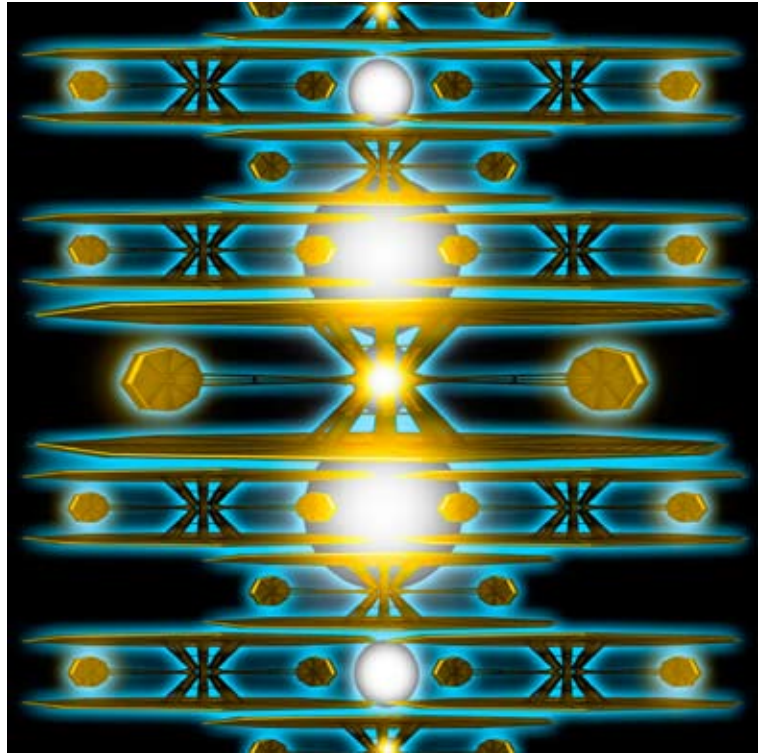


Psychedelic
