KIWANIS LAKE PUBLIC BOATING REGULATIONS

Due to the size of the Kiwanis Lake and because it is an urban area, the regulations listed below have been established for public safety.

- 1. City of Tempe Annual Boating Permit REQUIRED. Affixed to the stern of the boat. It is available at the Tempe Community Services Department – Parks & Recreation Office, 3500 S. Rural Road, Tempe. Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Holidays. Phone: (480) 350-5200.

Permit Fee

Annual Boat Permit Fee

\$5 per boat per year

- 2. Boating permitted only between sunrise and sunset.
- 3. Boats not to exceed 14 feet in length.
Exceptions:
 - 1. Inflatable boats must be at least 6 feet in length and not exceed 14 feet.
 - 2. Canoes must have proper flotation and not exceed 17 feet in length.
- 4. No rafts, innertubes, inflatable mattresses, catamarans or sailboards allowed.
- 5. No motors (electric or gas) may be used in Kiwanis Lake.
- 6. One serviceable Type I, II or III Coast Guard approved personal flotation device (life preserver) must be aboard boat for every person on board.
- 7. Children 12 years of age or younger must wear a serviceable U.S. Coast Guard Type I, II, or III personal flotation device at all times while the boat is underway.
- 8. NO overloading boat capacity.
- 9. NO swimming or wading permitted in Kiwanis Lake.
- 10. NO parking on launch area or driveways. Only launch boats at boat ramp at north end of Kiwanis Lake.
- 11. All City of Tempe Ordinances and Arizona State Boating Laws apply. (Arizona Revised Statutes, Arizona Game & Fish Commission Regulations and City of Tempe Code).
- 12. ALL BOATERS MUST ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR PERSONAL SAFETY.
