Adult Learn to Row-480-350-8069-Designed exclusively for first time rowers, this course will introduce the basics of rowing. Safety, boat handling, proper rowing technique and initial fitness development are stressed. Participants must be able to pass the 10 minute float test and have a basic level of fitness.
