This **Placemaking Community Town Hall Meeting** is the second in a series of public meetings for Tempe's **Urban Open Space Development Plan** with consultants **Project for Public Spaces**. PPS is an international, non-profit organization based in New York City dedicated to creating and sustaining public places that build communities. **Phil Myrick**, the featured speaker, is an authority on revitalizing city spaces, as well as an engaging thinker in livability, smart growth and the future of the city. **Project for Public Spaces** has done work in 48 states, 24 countries and 1,500 communities worldwide.

Tempe's **Urban Open Space Development Plan** will include a detailed assessment of the evolving open space needs of Tempe's **PAPAGO PARK**, **TOWN LAKE** and **MILL AVENUE DISTRICT** areas including regional / pocket / urban / historic parks, Light Rail Transit [LRT] access / connectivity, urban streetscapes, green streets, sustainable design concepts, pedestrian trails, bikepaths, wayfinding, linkages, maintenance standards and funding mechanisms.
