### Presentations available for your community

- **The Top Ten Consumer Scams:** Our presentation offers a description of the top ten consumer scams of 2007, listing red flags to watch for and empowering individuals to identify when they are being scammed.
- **Buying a Car: How to avoid being ripped off :** This presentation shows consumers what aspects of the process to be aware of during buying a car. We cover common misconceptions about the auto purchasing process.
- **Identity Theft:** This presentation explains to individuals the variety of ways they could potentially be a victim of identity theft, discusses what one can do to protect against ever having their identity stolen, and then recommends what sort of action should be taken if you experience identity theft.

- **Life Care Planning:** This presentation explains when it is necessary to have a Durable Health Care Power of Attorney, Living Will, Pre-Hospital Medical Directive, and the Durable Mental Health Care Power of Attorney
- **Predatory Lending: Red Flags** This presentation discusses the tactics used by predatory lenders and what to be aware of, as well what your rights are as a consumer.
- **Financial Exploitation of the Elderly ( Summary):** This presentation uses the results of our 2007 "Seniors Strike Back" mail project to walk the listener through common scams that are targeting the elderly.
- **Methamphetamine: The basics:** This presentation describes what the drug Methamphetamine is and how it affects the human body as well as what law enforcement is doing to help curb its use and the other criminal activity that is often associated with its use.
