

Public Notice - City of Tempe Call of Special Election

Notice is hereby given that the City of Tempe, Arizona, will hold a Special Election on May 20, 2014. At the Special Election, City voters will vote on Proposition 467, the City of Tempe General Plan 2040. Ballot language is available in the Tempe City Clerk's Office and on the internet at www.tempe.gov/election.

Individuals may file arguments for or against the General Plan 2040 which will be published in an election publicity pamphlet. **The last day to file arguments supporting or opposing the General Plan 2040 is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 19, 2014, in the Tempe City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 2nd Floor, 31 E. 5th Street, Tempe, Arizona.** Arguments cannot exceed 300 words in length and must contain the original, notarized signature of each person sponsoring it. The address and phone number for each signer must be included on the argument but will not be printed in the publicity pamphlet. At the time of filing, a deposit of \$100 per argument is required to offset a portion of the proportionate cost of paper and printing the pamphlet.
