Dr. Duane Roen has been tracing his roots since his teenage years, building a database with more than 32,000 ancestors. He and his wife have also been recording their family history since 1978 by writing more than 15,000 daily journal entries on their children and other family members. Duane worked with colleagues to establish courses on writing and recording family history in the School of Letters and Sciences at ASU. He serves as Assistant Vice Provost for University Academic Success Programs at ASU and as Interim Dean of University College and Interim Director of the School of Letters and Sciences.
