The POTW shall publish annually, in <u>a newspaper of general circulation that provides meaningful public</u> notice within the jurisdictions served by [the POTW], a list of the Users which, at any time during the previous twelve (12) months, were in Significant Noncompliance with applicable Pretreatment Standards and Requirements.
