Beginning Thursday, January 21, 2010, the City of Tempe Housing Services Division will begin accepting applications for its Supportive Housing for Homeless Individuals pilot program. Applications will be taken from 10:00 am until 1:00pm at Tempe First United Methodist Church - Urban Outreach , 215 E. University Dr. in Tempe that day.

After Tuesday, January 21, 2010, applications will be available at the City of Tempe Housing Services Division office, 21 E. Sixth St, #214 from 7:00am until 5:00pm, Monday through Friday, until further notice.

Due to federal funding requirements, applicants must be at or below 50 percent of the area median income and:

- homeless in the City of Tempe for a year or longer, and
- be living with a disability
