MATERIALS LIST

- **PAINT (in tubes)**

Cadmium Yellow Light	Sap Green
Cadmium Red Light	Phthalo Green
Alizarin Crimson	Yellow Ochre
Permanent Rose	Burnt Sienna
Ultramarine Blue	Raw Umber
Prussian Blue	
- **BRUSHES** –
 - ❖ FLAT, $\frac{3}{4}$ inch, synthetic – (This brush will have a short handle. Loew-Cornell, Artec, or Winsor & Newton suggested.)
 - ❖ ROUND – at least #6
- **PAPER:** 130# or better; Strathmore 400 Series is good to begin with
- **PALETTE:** Also called a Slant; be sure it is a watercolor palette with the spaces and a large mixing area
- **WATER CONTAINERS** – Please bring two
- **SMALL SQUIRT BOTTLE**
- **SPONGE** – Either natural or synthetic
- **RAGS OR PAPER TOWELS** – If you prefer your own. We have paper towels in class.
- **PENCIL** (HB or softer) and **ERASER** (Kneaded or Plastic)
- Suggested but not required: A small set of watercolor pencils to draw on the paper.
