Silversmithing for Beginners

- 2 oz. 14 gauge half-round sterling silver wire
- 1/3 oz. #75 hard solder
- 1/3 oz. #65 medium solder
- 1/3 oz. #56 easy solder
- 2" x 6" 20 gauge sheet sterling silver
- 1" x 6" 30 gauge sheet sterling silver
- 2 1/2" x 6" 22 gauge sheet sterling silver

Tools:

- Saw blades: 4/0, 5/0
- Safety glasses
- Burnishing tool (curved)
- Pliers: round nose, chain nose straight, flat nose, flush cutter, parallel action.
 - These can be purchased in sets at reduced price.
- Good pair of tweezers
- Pair cross-lock tweezers
- Soldering pick
- Set of small files
- Scribe
- Notebook and pen
- Fine point marking pen
- Steel 12" ruler

Do not buy serrated pliers.
