

Q. What, When, Where:

America Recycles Day

Saturday, November 13, 2010, 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Location: Household Products Collection Center 1320 E. University Drive Tempe, AZ

Q. What is the purpose of the event?

- Shred-A-Thon - to drop off your paper documents to be securely shredded
- E-Waste recycling - to bring your used electronics equipment to be recycled
- Bag Central Station - a drop-off location to bring your used plastic grocery bags to be recycled
- Nike Reuse-A-Shoe Program - a drop-off location to bring your used athletic shoes to be recycled.
- Household Hazardous Waste. All items collected will be disposed or reused in an environmentally safe manner.

- ERIC tour the mobile mini recycling museum

Q. Is this event only for Tempe Residents and do I have to provide proof of residency?

A. Tempe residents only.

Q. Is there a limit on the amount that can be shredded? What size of boxes will be accepted?

A. The limit is 5 boxes measuring approximately 10" wide X 20" long X 12" high

Q. If I bring my paper in a box, will my box be returned?

A. Yes, if you request it.

Q. How can I best prepare my documents for shredding?

A. Bring your loose documents in a box or bag. Boxes are preferred but bag are accepted. Remove any metal attachments, such as clips, clamps, binders, etc. Do not over-load boxes because staff will need to pick them up.

Q. Do you have to remove staples, paper clips, binder clips, notebooks, spiral binding?

A. It is not necessary to remove staples. Remove paper and binder clips. Remove paper from notebooks and spiral binding. Books will not be accepted.

Q. Can I bring floppy discs or CD's to the shredding event?

A. Yes, please place in a separate box or bag

Q. Can we view our items being shredded?

A. No, this is an off site service that Assured Security Document Destruction is providing. Items will be shredded at Assured Security Document Destruction main plant.

Q. Is the company bonded?

A. Yes, Assured Security Document Destruction is insured for additional questions call (480)-730-4133

Q. Can I arrive early and have my paper shredded?

A. Yes, if staff is available. The event officially starts at 7:00a.m.

Q. Will there be another Multi-purpose Recycling Day Green Day Challenge?

A. We plan to offer them twice per year - - in April & November

Q. What type of E-waste will be accepted?:

A. Computers, telephones, cellular phones, calculators, radios, stereos, DVD, video records, cameras are some of the electronic items accepted. No televisions that are considered consoles (Typically surrounded by wood/metal). Please refer to the household product collection center website: <http://www.tempe.gov/hhw/default.aspx>

Q. What happens to the shredded material?

A. All shredded documents are comingled into a master bale and then recycled at an approved pulp facility.

Q. What other recycling is being done at this event?

A. There will also be a Nike Reuse-a-Shoe drop-off where individuals can drop off their used athletic shoes for recycling. There will also be a drop-off container to allow individuals to drop off their plastic grocery bags for recycling.

Q. If I can not make it to the Multi-purpose Recycling Day Green Day Challenge, what other opportunities are available?

A. Document drop offs are acceptable at the facility, 225 West Lodge Drive, call 480-730-4133, open daily 9:00am-2:00pm Monday-Friday. \$ 0.18 a pound, a donation, or mention the event.
