Will practice fields be available? YES. Practice Fields will be available through the Recreation Coordinator's office (Bobbi Jones) starting Tuesday September 1, 2009. Practice Fields will be assigned in 1.5 hour time slots. Please do not contact the Parks & Recreation front office unless you want to pay a rental fee.

Can I recruit my own team? YES!

Coaches must make sure all players meet the age requirement. If you are unsure, please ask the Coordinator. Birth certificates will be required, but it is up to the coach to be responsible for making sure all players are within the age range for the league.

Do I need to be a Tempe Resident? NO! All youth are invited.

What if I can't afford the complete registration fee?

The City of Tempe offers Fee Assistance to any Tempe and Guadalupe residents that want to participate but can not afford the full registration fee. One visit to our offices on the 2nd floor of the City Library, bring a picture i.d. and proof of your address in Tempe or Guadalupe. (Phone, utility bill, lease agreement etc.), and fill out a one page form, and fee assistance can be awarded at that time.

REGISTRATION ON BACK. TURN OVER AND FILL OUT COMPLETELY.

Coaches must make sure all players meet the age requirement. If you are unsure, please ask the Coordinator. Birth certificates will be required, but it is up to the coach to be responsible for making sure all players are within the age range for the league. League Coordinator will determine if a team may be placed in any division that is out of their age range.

The 14U age group will also have a Competitive and Community division, where the more advanced and experienced teams will be in the Competitive Division and less experienced teams will be in the Community Division. All 14U players and teams will sign up under the same Activity Code.

- 10U is for players who are 8, 9, or 10 years old on April 30, 2010 (primarily 3rd & 4th graders)**
- 12U is for player who are 10, 11 or 12 years old on April 30, 2010 (primarily 5th & 6th graders)**
- 14U is for players who are 12, 13, or 14 years old on April 30, 2010 (primarily for 7 & 8th graders)**
- 16U is for players who are 14, 15, or 16 yrs. old on April 30, 2009 (primarily for 9th & 10th graders)**
