WELCOME & INTRODUCTIONS

FOLLOW-UP ON NEIGHBORHOOD CONCERNS

Several comments were received at the first meeting regarding neighborhood concerns. The following information was provided:

Frat House(s): Code Enforcement (Jan Koehn) was contacted. Code Enf. Has not received any calls about the property since 2003.

Residential Parking Permit signs: Missing signs(s) are being replaced.

Street Name sign obstructed on Encanto: tree has been trimmed

Landscaping needed trimming at Encanto and Rural: Request was forwarded

COLLEGE AVENUE COMMENTS

Because the Daley Park neighborhood is adjacent to College Ave, City staff took a few minutes to ask team members for feedback about the current College Avenue project.

UPDATED TRAFFIC INFORMATION

Traffic data was collected in October 2008. The daily traffic volumes and speeds (85th percentile) by direction were presented for Encanto east, Encanto, west, and Ventura Dr. In addition, charts were presented to depict the variation of traffic throughout the day. It was noted that traffic in the area does not have typical morning and afternoon peaks. Another graphic was presented to compare the Sept 2007 data with the October 2008 data. On each street the traffic volumes have gone down. It was also noted that the speed on Encanto in front of the park has increased from 29 mph to 34 mph in the last year.

SUMMARY OF TRAFFIC PROBLEMS

A map was presented to graphically depict the neighborhood traffic problems that were identified by team members. With a few exceptions, it was agreed that the map presented the concerns correctly. The Action Team asked for three revisions: 1) add a pedestrian crossing concern on Encanto at the east end of the park,; 2) add parking concern on the east end of Solana Dr: and 3) add disregard for sign at Encanto and Rural.

ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES

City staff reviewed a list of advantages and disadvantages for traffic calming.

TRAFFIC CALMING TOOLS

A list of traffic calming tools that could be applied to this neighborhood was discussed. The list of tools was based on the neighborhood traffic problems.
