RE: Daley Park Neighborhood Testing of Traffic Calming Devices

A neighborhood meeting was held on February 17, 2009 to present the Daley Park Draft Action Plan to residents. The Draft Plan was prepared by the STEP (Streetscape and Transportation Enhancement Program) Action Team with assistance from City staff. A drawing of the Draft Action Plan was posted on-line and can still be viewed at this time.

The STEP process requires that the Draft Plan be available for review and comment for a period of 30 days. The review period began February 17. During that time, residents could comment in one of three ways:

- ◆ By attending the meeting and filling out the questionnaire
- ◆ By viewing and commenting on-line
- ◆ By requesting a copy of the drawing be mailed and returning written comments or phoning in comments.

The question that was asked was as follows:

**“Are you in favor of the traffic calming measures
proposed by the Daley Park Action Team?”**

The comment period closed on March 19, 2009. The results of the voting were as follows:

In favor?

- ◆ **YES: 23**
- ◆ **NO: 1**

As a result, City staff is proceeding with the testing phase of the project. The current schedule is for the test measures to be in place beginning April 3, 2009. The measures are expected to be in place for a minimum of 45 days.
