RUBY TUESDAY BUILDING 510 SOUTH MILL AVENUE

Completed in 1994, this redevelopment of a 0.24 acre former gas station site includes retail space along Mill Avenue, in addition to the prominent restaurant. Projected arcades provide shade for pedestrians and sidewalk dining, as well as serving to integrate the contemporary structure into the historic-influenced downtown setting. A prominent architectural feature at the corner further distinguishes the project.
