## SUPER SATURDAY NIGHT

Super Bowl events took center stage in Tempe last week with the city being showcased to the country as a spot for great entertainment and fun. **Super Bowl Saturday Night** attracted approximately 30,000 people to Tempe Beach Park, according to Tempe police officials. The Feb. 2 performance by **Counting Crows** and **Boys Like Girls**, punctuated by appearances from NFL players, provided free entertainment to people from around the country. Afterward, the NFL produced a 30-minute fireworks show with explosions that pounded the ground and lit the sky continuously with glorious color. The **Tempe Center for the Arts** was the site of a party where special lighting of the TCA and outdoor pavilion took about a week to set up.



## TOPPING OFF

**Avenue Communities** celebrated the topping off of Tempe's tallest building Wednesday. The first of their three 30-story towers reached its pinnacle this month.
