If a construction project is financed or assisted by a United States Federal Government Agency (FTA, FHWA, etc.), the wages you receive while working on the project are covered by Federal laws known as the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (DBRA). Your employer must pay you no less than the wage established for your trade under the DBRA. That wage must be posted on the job site in a prominent and accessible place where it can be easily read by all employees. There are additional rights and protections you have as a construction worker on the job.
