Parking of Private and City Owned Vehicles

PURPOSE

To establish a risk management and customer service approach in relation to private and city owned vehicle parking.

POLICY

Personal Vehicles

Parking of personal vehicles on Fire Department property is prohibited in other than designated appropriate parking spaces. Parking directly behind in-service apparatus bays is prohibited. Parking of personal vehicles in apparatus rooms is prohibited.

Exceptions

- During shift change between the hours of 0700 and 0830.
- Permission granted by a chief officer.
- During projects such as construction or parking lot maintenance or repair
- So we may better serve our customers, Fire Department employees working at Fire Administration are prohibited from parking in the five spaces to the west of the main walkway leading to Fire Administration.

City Owned Vehicles

Parking of city vehicles on Fire Department property is prohibited in other than designated appropriate parking spaces.

Exceptions

- The Duty BC may park behind BC271 inside the bay at Fire Station 1.
- Duty BC shift change between 0700-0830 hours.
- The Fire Investigations Van may park in the bay at Fire Station 1 as specified.
- During projects such as construction or parking lot maintenance or repair.
- Short term needs such as unloading or vehicle charging.
- So we may better serve our customers, Fire Department employees with city vehicles are prohibited from parking in the five spaces to the west of the main walkway leading to Fire Administration.
