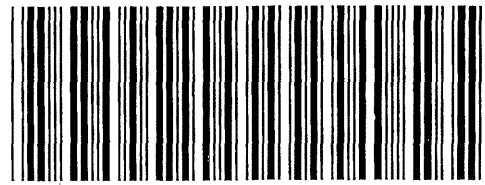

**CERTIFICATE OF THE VICE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE,  
ARIZONA, RELATIVE TO THE SPECIAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN AND FOR  
THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, ON MAY 21, 2002.**

The Vice Mayor (acting in the absence of the Mayor) and Council of the City of Tempe, Arizona, hereby certify as follows:

1. Pursuant to the resolution passed and adopted by the Mayor and Council on January 17, 2002, an election was duly and regularly held on May 21, 2002, for the purpose of approving the issuance and sale of bonds in the total principal amount of \$158,000,000 (the "bonds") to provide funds to make various municipal improvements.

2. The election had been conducted and the official returns thereof have been filed as required by law and that the total number of votes cast at the special bond election in answer to the question submitted were as follows:

1. Water And Sewer Improvement	14,831	3,836	18,667
2. Street Improvements	14,707	4,018	18,725
3. Law Enforcement	14,365	4,270	18,635
4. Fire Protection	15,702	2,993	18,695
5. Community Services/ Park Improvements	13,254	5,402	18,656

The tabulated votes for each specified bond question is set forth in the attached final cumulative report.

3. The majority of the votes cast at the election was for creating the indebtedness of the City in the total authorized principal amount of \$158,000,000 by the issuance and sale of all of the bonds as described in all of the questions. The Vice Mayor and Council hereby order the issuance and sale of all the bonds of this issue.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Vice Mayor and members of this Council present at the canvass have hereunto placed their hands and caused the same to be attested by the Clerk and the seal of the City of Tempe to be affixed hereto on May 30, 2002.
