

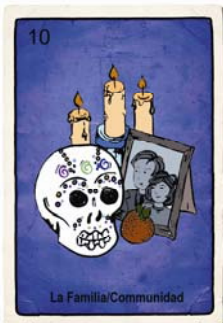
MIXING IT UP *Loteria*

Artists celebrate connections with others.



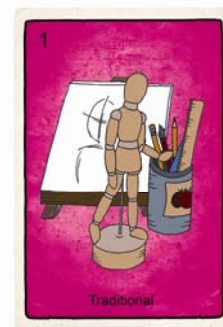
Labor

Traditional

Artists use old world knowledge and techniques like anatomy, perspective and shading to make their artworks look real.

Artists use affordable processes for wide distribution of dramatic, attention-grabbing designs.
