Tempe Historic Preservation Commission

The Tempe Historic Preservation Commission advises the City Council in all matters concerning historic preservation. The mission of the Commission is:

- to provide protection for significant properties and archeological sites that represent important aspects of Tempe's heritage;
- to enhance the character of the community by taking such properties and sites into account during development; and,
- to assist owners in the preservation and restoration of their properties.

The Tempe Historic Preservation Commission consists of nine members, who are Tempe residents with a demonstrated interest in or knowledge of historic preservation. Terms are for three years. The membership of the Commission includes four at-large members and five professionals, drawn from the following disciplines, with no more than two such professionals from the same discipline:

- architecture,
- architectural history,
- archeology,
- historic preservation law,
- history,
- landscape architecture,
- planning,
- building construction, or
- other related field.

The Commission must hold a minimum of four public meetings/hearings per year. Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the Commission chair or five or more members of the Commission. (City Code, Chapter 14A, Section 14A-3; Zoning and Development Code, Part 1, Chapter 3, Section 1-304)
