- ◆ Approximately 220 veterans have participated in the Tempe Veterans' Court.
- ◆ More than 50 veterans have successfully completed treatment program requirements to resolve their cases.
- ◆ Over 150 veterans have received, or are currently receiving, case management services specific to their needs.
- ◆ Through the collaboration with local partners, support and rehabilitation services are provided to veterans through comprehensive substance abuse and mental health treatment programs; educational services; and community referrals for housing, childcare, transportation, and crisis intervention needs.

For those veterans whose struggles lead them to the criminal justice system, the Veterans' Court docket ensures that we leave no veteran behind.
