A potty-trained child can do the following:

- Tell the adult they have to go potty **BEFORE** they have to go. They must be able to say the words “I have to go potty” **BEFORE** they have to go.
- Pull down their underwear and pants and get them back up without assistance.
- Clean themselves after using the toilet.
- Get off the potty by themselves.
- Wash and dry hands.
- Go directly back to the room without directions.
- Postpone going if they must wait for someone who is in the bathroom or if we are outside and away from the classroom
