

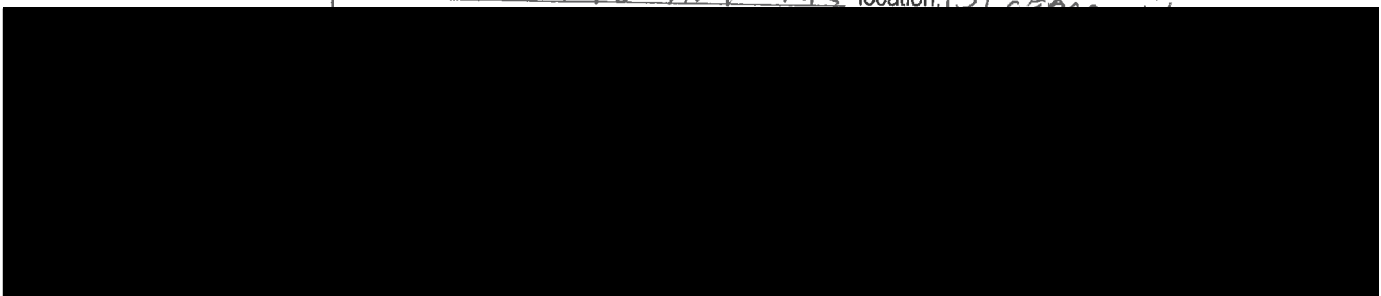

The following neighbors responded (in alphabetical order):

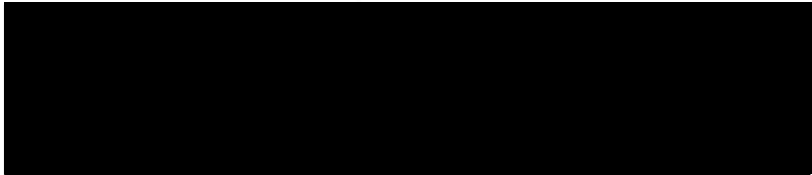

My budget at this phase is simple.

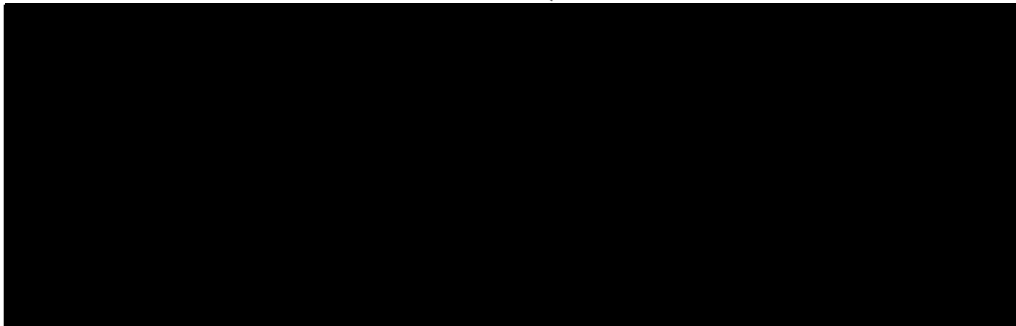
1/3. - design fee / layout, meetings, material research & selection, colors, office overhead, insurance, fees
