Law Day 2019: FREE SPEECH FREE PRESS FREE SOCIETY

THE CONTEST: Draw, paint, sketch or create a collage to represent Free Speech, Free Press, Free Society. The art project can be as simple as a crayon on paper drawing or as complex of a medium as you may want to use. Students should be instructed to use their imaginations and be creative. The Court will provide a half-hour interactive presentation to help students conceptualize and give focus to this project.

WHO MAY PARTICIPATE: All 4th, 5th and 6th grade students in the City of Tempe are eligible to enter. Students may work alone or in groups of two. The following requirements need to be met before posters will be accepted:

- Posters may not exceed 18"x24" and tri-fold poster boards will not be accepted.
- Student name(s), teacher name, grade and school must be written *clearly* on the back of the poster.

DEADLINE: All entries are due by April 10, 2019. If you would like to schedule a half-hour class presentation or would like to schedule pick-up for art contest entries, please contact Casey Simmons at (480) 350-2894 or by e-mail at casey_simmons@tempe.gov.

AWARDS: All entries will be displayed at the Tempe History Museum from April 23 through May 12. Winners and their parents will be invited to attend a City Council meeting on April 25, 2019 at 5:45 p.m. There will be two \$50 first place winners, two \$25 second place winners, two \$20 third place winners and one honorable mention. Teachers will also be invited to attend and will be recognized at the City Council Meeting.
