



Materials for Acrylic and Oil Painting

- **Paint colors:**

titanium white	ultramarine blue	Yellow oxide or
cadmium yellow light	cerulean blue	yellow ochre
cadmium red light	Prussian blue	Burnt sienna
acra violet	Phthalo green and/or	Raw umber
alizarin crimson	hookers green	

- **Medium:**
 - acrylic painters – retarding medium may be desirable for people who find their paint dries too quickly, but it is not required. A small squirt bottle for water may also be helpful.
 - oil painters – liquin (highly recommended), copal, or a mixture of dammar varnish and turpentine is required for all oil painters. Bring a small covered jar to store it in.

- **Brushes:** flats (bristle or synthetic): #2 or #3, #7 and #12. A flat 1” watercolor brush is also good, especially for acrylic.
 - Please note: a good guide to buying brushes is to look at the handle and ferrule. An inferior handle indicates an inferior brush and you will be disappointed with the results.

- **Palette:** paper, plastic or glass (at least 9” x 12”).

- **Surface:** canvas, canvas board (recommended for beginners), or Gessoed masonite (at least 12” x 14”).

- **Wash:** due to the circumstances under which we paint, odorless turpentine or turpenoid is required for all oil painters. Please bring a large screw top jar or can. Acrylic cleans with water.

- You may prefer to bring rags or your own paper towels. If not, we have paper towels.

- And last, bring your curiosity, your open mind and your loving heart.

Either oil or acrylic paint is fine (no watercolor in this class). Oil dries slowly (turpentine clean-up) and acrylic dries quickly (water clean-up).
