Planning Meeting – November 1st, 2019

- We created a brainstorm board with ideas from the Pop-Up event to start the basis of the planning meeting conversation. Residents noted their favorite ideas on the boards so we could gain a better understanding of their wants.

DECORATIVE:

- Paper cranes: create large scale ones to hang from the trees
 - Write memories/stories on the cranes to display in the trees
- Sand Art: variations include...
 - Artist pre-makes and displays at event
 - Large piles of sand brought into park specifically for event project
 - Residents fill bottles of sand
 - Create a sand mandala
- Luminaries: place around meditation garden

PROJECTS:

- Participatory project with local artist:
 - Bring a tent for artist(s) to display work as well as offer a collaborative project to execute within it
 - Include student artwork
 - Collaborative painting with butcher paper (large roll)
 - Children and adult workshops
- Chalk Art: use sidewalks
- Projections on blow-up screens
 - Students from film class to create movie about neighborhood
- Decorate coffee mugs: each mug has a thoughtful question attached to prompt for welcoming conversation

MUSIC:

- ASU Mariachi Ensemble
- 3 bands @ 45 minute set times
- Bands positioned facing away from apartments

PERFORMANCE:

- Storytelling: get to know your neighbor, favorite memory, etc.
- Walking meditation through garden while reading stories in the trees
