

Printmaking/Book Binding; Beginning Teaching Artist: Lisa Zirbel

No materials needed for day one. All material requirements will be discussed in class or by email notification.

Required Materials:

- One linoleum 5" x 6" relief block. Example:
 - <https://www.dickblick.com/products/blick-readycut/>
- One relief carving multitool. Example:
 - <https://www.dickblick.com/products/speedball-linoleum-cutters/>
- *One spool of linen bookbinding thread
 - Waxed or unwaxed. Color is student's preference
- *Heavy needle (to fit thread)
- X-acto knife and spare blades.
 - Ensure blade number matches the handle number
- Pencil and eraser
- Two full sheets of BFK Rives paper, white, 22" x 30"
- 2 sheets Book board, Davey board or chipboard 8.5" x 6" min.
 - the back covers of sketch/watercolor pads work for this

Optional:

- *Bookbinding Awl
- *Curved bookbinding needle
- *Bone Folder
- PVA, PH Neutral Glue
- Sketchbook

*These items can typically be found online in affordable bookbinding "starter kits."

Additional materials will be provided or requested prior to projects. In cases of economic difficulty, please speak to the instructor for supply alternatives.
