Jared Kluge requested that a bus route be added along Price Road to connect to the city of Chandler. He also said that buses should have dedicated travel lanes and priority at traffic signals while vehicles should not share a lane with the Streetcar. He also said that there are plenty of parking garages in downtown Tempe and that Mill Avenue should have no vehicular parking on the street, and look at “pedestrianization” of Mill Ave.
