### **Agenda Item 2 – Committee Goals**

Committee identified issues that will need Outreach Committee action.

1. Beautification Awards – This is a needed and popular community program that recognizes businesses and residences for architectural and landscaping innovation. Outreach will identify ways to creatively promote both the businesses/homeowners and the selection process.
2. TIP Manual – Commissioner Wilson suggests that the TIP Manual be sent to every HOA/NA chairperson in Tempe. If possible, Neighborhood Services should provide limited technical support to answer questions by phone if and when the TIP manual is used to solve community problems. Track successes/failures and tweak manual accordingly.
3. Maryanne Corder Neighborhood Grant Program – Identify and aggressively promote innovative community projects funded by the neighborhood grants.
4. Neighbor of the Year Award/Neighborhood Leadership Workshop – Find ways to improve the workshop process and build attendance. Begin to build lists of potential panel/workshop moderators and experts from around the city. Work on obtaining prominent keynote speakers from around the Valley to draw participants.
5. Commissioner Wasko suggests that other committees identify Outreach items within their own agendas and bring them to the Outreach Committee for further discussion and action.
