

Disposal of Dirt, Rock, or Concrete

- Dirt, rock, and concrete are non-collectible materials that city-code restricts residents from placing in alleyways and refuse containers.
- Solid Waste Services has purchased special **10-yard roll off containers** designed exclusively for the disposal of dirt, rock, or concrete.
- This container will be emptied once every two weeks and be billed at the rate of \$75.00 drop fee **and** weight billed per ton at the current gate rate at the disposal center (currently \$36.00 per ton).

ARTICLE VI. SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

Sec. 28-51. Prohibited disposal.

(a) Any solid waste which does not comply with the provisions of this chapter will not be collected by the city and will subject the owner or occupant of the property, or the owner or occupant of abutting property in the case of noncomplying solid waste in the right-of-way, to penalties for violation of the city code.

(b) The following shall not be placed in city-owned containers or in any alley, right-of-way, or curbside:

- (3) Dirt, rock, construction or demolition material, or non-collectible materials.
